After this reluctant group committed to pray for three months, we all knew God was leading us to step out. The excuses didn't work.

God has grown me through Teen MOPS. I am less judgmental. I have a better understanding of the plight of poverty and hopelessness. Although I could be the teen mom's grandmother, the girls appreciate that someone cares, someone will listen, someone will love them. They don't seem to care that I'm white, suburban, and of a different generation.

What's required? Availability the 2nd and 4th Wednesday September –May. Attendance at Steering committee meetings, once a month. Commitment to pray for Teen MOPS.

What's needed?

- ◆ **MOPS Mall coordinator** –organize donations and distribute them through a points system.
- ◆ **Finance Coordinator**- manage financial transactions and possible fund raising.
- ◆ **Crafts Coordinator**- develop craft projects or life application demonstrations, i.e. haircutting
- ◆ **Hospitality Coordinator**- coordinate meals, provide a warm, fun, environment.
- ◆ **MOPPET Workers**- hold babies, sing songs, play with children, teach Bible stories
- ◆ **Meal providers**- prepare a meal for either pick up or delivery to the Buffalo Christian Center for approximately 12 people.
